

Student appearance, dress and uniforms policy

Policy statement

Uniforms are not just about appearance, they are about identity, and this is first and foremost the school's identity. Queen's Qatar considers school uniforms a benefit for all students, as they facilitate a neat and tidy appearance, and create the conditions that allow all students to be treated equably.

General appearance guidelines

- Uniforms should be contemporary and clean in design and fit.
- Uniforms should stand out from the crowd of other local schools.
- Items can be sustainably sourced where it is sensible to do so.
- All items of uniform should be clearly marked with the student's name.
- The school encourages students to keep themselves clean and tidy.
- Religious dress such as headscarves and leggings is integrated into the school's uniform. The school identity takes precedence over, but accommodates, student identities.
- In general jewellery should not be worn.
- A wristwatch may be worn.
- No shaved or sculpted hair. Long hair must be tied back or up.
- No tattoos or body piercings, other than ear piercings. Girls may wear one pair of small stud earrings, one at the bottom of each earlobe.

Boys' school uniform

- School shirt.
- School shorts for Primary and/or trousers for Primary and Secondary. Shorts must be below the knee
- Underwear and undershirts/vests must be worn.
- School jumper.
- Sweatshirt, track top or sports outerwear, branded.

Girls' school uniform

- School dress for FS1/2, plus cardigan, below the knee
- School blouse, with accompanying school skirt/trousers for primary and secondary. Skirts must be below the knee or full length.
- Underwear must be worn.
- School cardigan
- Sweatshirt, track top or sports outerwear, branded.

P.E. and Swimming kit

- School PE shirt
- School PE shorts/track suit bottoms
- Suitable sports training shoes
- School tracksuit tops (in colder locations)
- Swimming shorts (boys)
- One-piece swimming costume (girls) plus knee length leggings.
- Towel
- Swimming cap (long hair)
- Goggles (optional)
